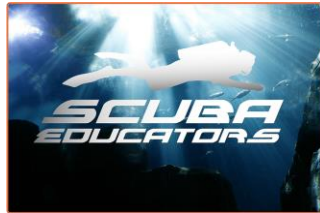


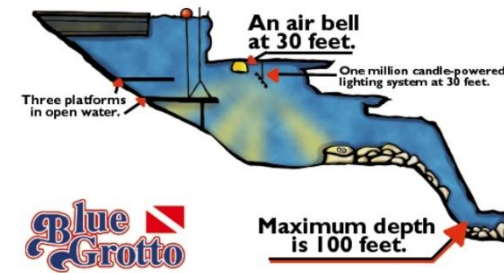
# Open Water Scuba Course



- Class Dates: TBD
- Class Location: TBD or Via Virtual (Zoom, Skype, etc.)
- Pool Location: TBD
- Course Tuition: \$380.00 (Includes all course materials and basic equipment)
- Personal Mask, Fins, Snorkel, and Boots: \$250.00 (approximately)
- Students must complete 4 check-out dives to receive certification.
- Open Water student gear: BC, Regulator, Tanks, Weights and Weight Belt are provided during the open water course.
- Lodging, Meals, Wet Suit and Transportation for check-out dives is not included.



# Blue Grotto-Williston, Fl.



The dive begins at the mouth of the cavern, which is 80ft wide and 20ft high. Look from topside into the sharp blue of the pool and you will understand why Blue Grotto is well known for its exceptional visibility year-round. 30ft below the surface is the only air bell available to spring divers in the region, filled with fresh compressed air that allows you a unique opportunity to stop and talk with your buddy under the water. Descending from there, at 50ft a permanent guideline brings you to the crescent shaped cavern where you will experience an array of fossils along the walls of the chamber and an abundance of aquatic life waiting for a free handout.

## Trip Cost:

### Three Day (3): (Thursday, Friday, Saturday)

- ◆ Check-out Dives: The Blue Grotto-Williston, Fl. \$250.00 plus tax (Includes Dive Fee, Air and Rental Equipment)
- ◆ **Non-Student diver(s):** Responsible for Park Guest Fee
- ◆ All student divers/non-divers are responsible for their lodging, meals, transportation, and wetsuit.
- ◆ **Scuba Equipment** for students performing their check-outs (BC, Regulator, Weights, and Tanks) will be provided for students conducting Open Water Check-out Dives.

### Tentative Dive Schedule:

- Thursday- (1-Dives within NDL)
- Friday- (3 Dives within NDL)
- Saturday- (2 Dive within NDL)

## Commonly asked questions about scuba diving.....

### Is learning to dive easy?

Yes, it only takes six days to learn to Scuba dive. Youth as young as twelve (12) years of age can learn to dive.

### Do I need to be a great swimmer?

No, but you must know how, and will have to swim a few laps and tread water.

### Is it claustrophobic to scuba dive?

It is not claustrophobic to scuba dive because you are in control and can swim and move where you want to.

### Does the certification ever expire?

No, but if you have not been in a year or two it is best to take a refresher class.

### Is scuba diving expensive?

Scuba diving is no more expensive than golf and some other sports.

### Will I receive scuba information after I get certified?

We will be sending you an email or flyer (upon your request) about the trips and classes we may be offering.

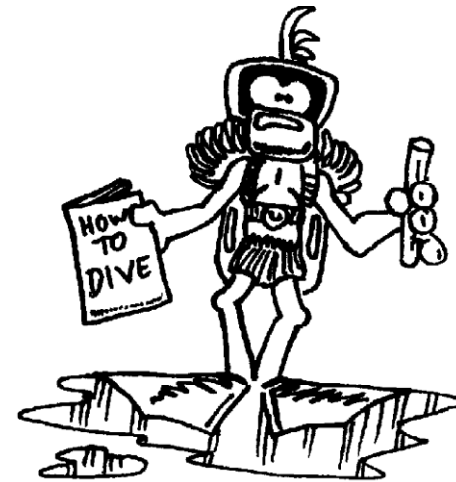
### What if I want to buy all my equipment up front?
